

Grading criteria

To pass the course, it is mandatory to hand in the three individual assignments, to participate in the seminar and to participate in and contribute to the exercises.

Grading is based on evaluation of the following hand-ins: Individual assignments #1 and #2 (Fail/Pass).

Individual assignment #3 (Graded 3, 4, 5).

Participation in seminar (Fail/Pass).

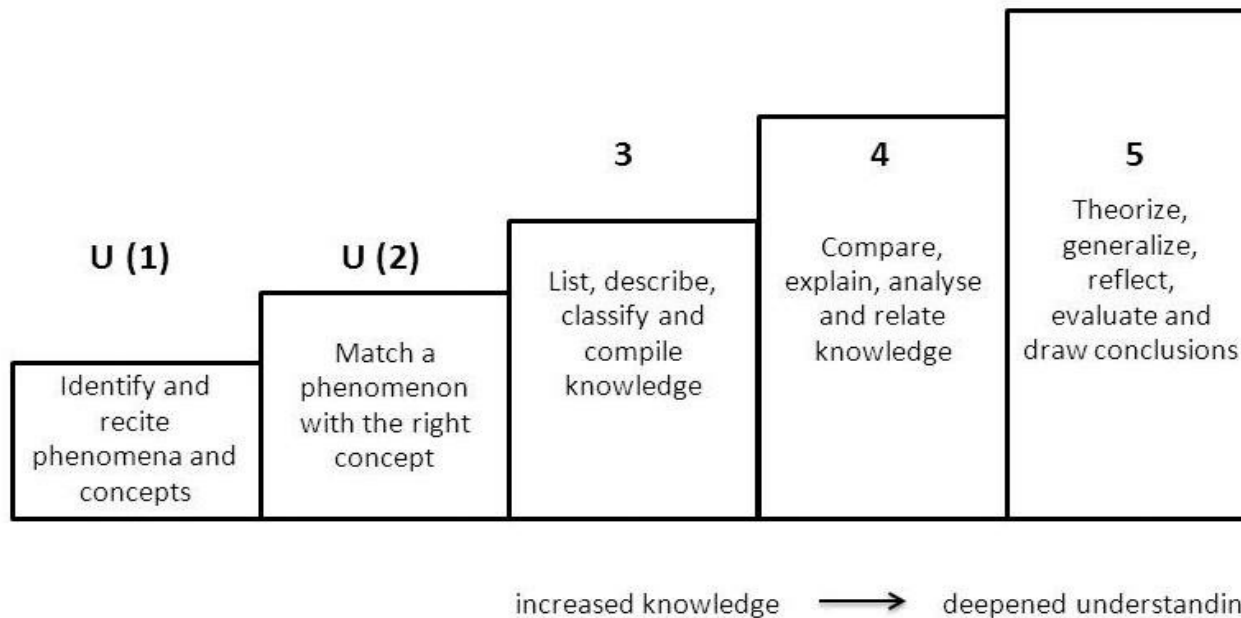
Participation in group exercises and contributing to the reports (Fail/Pass).

For grade 3 on the course the requirements are: Passed individual assignments, participation in the seminar and participation in and contribution to exercises.

Grade 4 and 5 on the course are based entirely on individual assignment #3 according to the *principles of grading* below.
