The first column to the left of the schedule indicates the theme for each course week (CW ranging from 1 to 10).

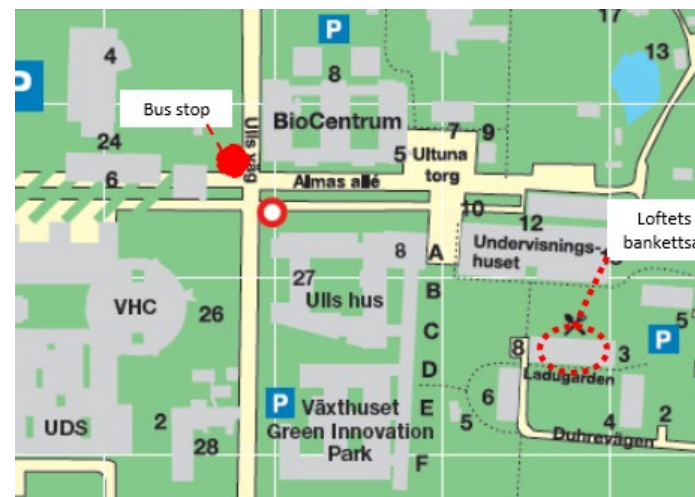
