All activities listed here have indicative dates. Actual dates and times will be communicated on the course Canvas page, which is open to students after the information seminar. Access can be requested by writing to the course leader.

- Jan/Feb: Information Seminar
- *May:* Introduction Seminar [mandatory]
- *Jan—Aug:* Students independently secure an internship position of at least 5 weeks full-time equivalent and get it approved by the course coordinator via Canvas
- *May–Oct:* Students independently conduct literature studies and the internship at their own pace in coordination with their internship organisation
- *after the Internship:* Students write an Analytical Reflection Paper (ARP; c. 2 weeks)
- *end of Nov, mid-Jan:* Students submit and present their ARP; there are two opportunities for this, one of which students need to submit to and present at
